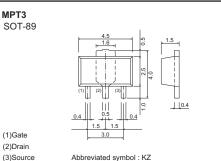

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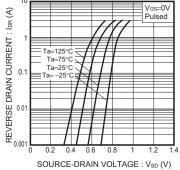


Fig.5 Reverse Drain Current vs. Source-Drain Voltage (I)

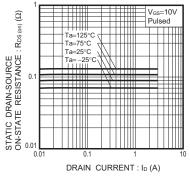


Fig.7 Static Drain-Source On-State Resistance vs. Drain Current (I)

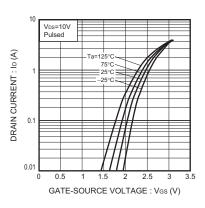
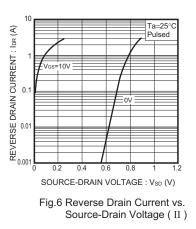


Fig.3 Typical Transfer Characteristics



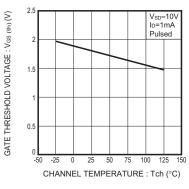


Fig.9 Gate Threshold Voltage vs. Channel Temperature
